OPENING: The meeting was opened by Erin with the reading of the purpose of subcommittee, reading of the Commitment to Service and a quote from Bill D.

- 2. **Purpose and objectives:** To serve as a resource to help educate Delegates and Alternate Delegates of groups and Intergroups to the Annual Business Conference by providing information on what is read prior to attending conference, as well as helping delegates be more informed in helping their members/groups practice traditions and concepts and holding group consciences

GROUP BUSINESS

- 1. **Trifold:** Discussion was held on creating a Tri-fold for distribution to group/intergroup delegates. Aaron volunteered to start working on preliminary creation of trifold. Bob proposed that we not get lost in the creation of a trifold, that we get something done that is 1-2 pages so that it can be ready for the next ABC, making mention that time is getting short. Bob P. volunteered to contact WSO to find out if there is a way to do a mass email or any other way to get the new trifold out to groups/intergroups, provided that he was sent specific instructions on what, where, who he needed to contact to get this done.

- 3. **Buddy System:** Bob P. stated that a "Buddy System" for new delegates is used in AA and that it is very helpful to new delegates. A new delegate is paired up with someone that has been to the ABC previously and gently guides them through the process.
- 4. **Committee Name:** Jim expressed feelings that maybe the name of the subcommittee be renamed, he felt that the present name sounds "authoritative". A motion was made that going forward the name of the subcommittee be changed to Delegate Support Subcommittee. After a short discussion the motion was passed unanimously.
