Australia

Overall/Meetings: 39 meetings, 6 intergroups

Studies/ Workshops: With spring in the air, we find a renewed spring in our steps and recovery. October saw another successful delivery of the 2 day online Ready Set Go to over 60 participants from around the world. Participants are excited and keen to participate in the format. It was sponsored by the Global Members Subcommittee. There are also weekly RSG Workshops which commenced on October 21, will be held on Wednesdays until Thanksgiving, sponsored by the Western Great Lakes Intergroup. Toni and Monique managed the group of 35 easily on the Zoom, having a Tech assistant made it easier for the hosts. Participants shared how good they felt to be connected with others from different countries in the workshop.

We also had a further meeting about 18 week Yellow 12 Step Book and Traits study groups for 2021, which we will hopefully announce in November.

The committee also announced another workshop for November which will be the last of the year.

Literature: With global, we took a meeting re furthering the discussion of printing our own literature here in Australia. We have committed to gathering quotes for printing and also for distribution with the view added these to a submission by our chair to WSO.

Mexico	Overall/Meetings: Online meetings continue to flourish, there has been no return to face-to-face meetings as yet. A decision has been taken to shift the Monday face-to-face meeting in
South Africa	Johannesburg to an online Intergroup-run meeting permanently with immediate effect, and the WSC website is being updated accordingly. The meeting content will be donated to Soweto for when that face-to-face meeting opens.
	Studies/ Workshops: The second RSG zoom weekend has just been completed, hosted with a hybrid team from the Global Subcommittee alongside local SA team members, in the spirit of creating a self-supporting framework. This time, the tech hosting team was all local, with just Global for backup and one of the facilitators was also a SA local. There were 37 bookings for the event, and it was another major success. The entire organisation of the event was also handled seamlessly by the Intergroup Admin person, who has developed a structure designed to make the admin process of organising a workshop seamless. She has also offered to assist other countries with a version tailored to accommodate their needs.
	Service Structure: The Intergroup is well established now, and has successfully dealt with a difficult group conscience process where censuring the behaviour of a member needed to be addressed. A respectful but clear process was successfully followed, in line with the guidelines in the BRB, and the committee has strengthened as a result. Sadly, our sponsorship coordinator will be emigrating shortly, but the team is putting a process in place to address future requests for sponsorship. Translations: Not needed at this time.
	Literature: A payment for 60% of the subsidised literature from WSO has been made and the funds have been received and acknowledged. There are only 8 BRBs currently remaining in the Intergroup stock. Discussions with WSO around printing locally are well underway and it is hoped to have a solution in place by the start of the new year.
