We operate on the principle of attraction not promotion so we respond to requests for support. We listen, seeking to understand what these groups are looking for, and attempt to meet their expressed need as best as we can from our pool of resources, facilitating universal inclusiveness, accessibility and affordability of literature and ACA recovery resources (Tradition 5, carrying the ACA message). We honour Tradition 4 (autonomy) for all groups.

Partner within WSO ACA and our Fellowships around the world to unify our ACA recovery resources.

GOALS

- 1 Increased accessibility and affordability processes for literature publishing and distribution for emerging countries.
- 2 Increased accessibility and inclusiveness to ACA recovery resources through meeting support, studies, service committees, workshops etc.
- 3 Supporting translations and equitable access to the WSO ACA Fellowship and organization.
- 4 Partner with Europe and North America in unifying our WSO ACA resources for our world-wide Fellowship.

COUNTRY AND REGIONAL HIGHLIGHTS

Updates:

East Asia [Sean H]	We've registered the East Asia Intergroup. We're continuing to raise awareness of the 2022 ABC and AWC. We've started looking at the ABC ballot voting process to meet the March deadline.
Japan [Eriko]	Global provided service support to the Japanese ACOA Intergroup business meeting.
Thailand [Brian Ph]	We have two weekly zoom meetings and our face-to-face meeting on Saturday mornings is discontinued due to COVID. Started shifting Young Adults on Saturday in Discord out of the pilot version. Promoted the group through Facebook and using councilors at universities. Also tried to register it as a new meeting but didn't take it. Consulted with Alaska and may have to email to confirm a new meeting.
South Asia [Shangreila]	
India	 We had the 3rd consecutive well attended IG meeting on Feb 26, '22 Sunil A agreed to stay on as CP InterGroup. But we have organised the IG for more participative members. Minutes drafted, approved and posted with a good action plan for next month. February 2022 saw us conduct one PI activity at an AA convention. At the convention some older members (dual membership) who had dropped out due to COVID rejoined our online meetings. On site ACA literature was distributed and ACA meetings were held. Rs.1950 was spent on displays and pamphlets. Money is spent from IG kitty. As a direct result 8 newcomers found home :-) and have joined the meetings. We started a weekly Hindi only meeting with the Essentials Pamphlet translated into Hindi (with the disclaimer that it is not ACA conference approved). First meeting was held yesterday evening (Friday 4th March 2022, exactly two calender months after we started LPG meetings) : We are encouraging this meeting to evolve into a group (already 12-15 people attended) but InterGroup India (and thus Global) will support them. We have had a round of discussions on Ballots. Surprisingly it was attended by many members. We will introduce Google form and voting this week. The IG's suggestion on speaker meetings is well received and after Louis B in Jan 2022, we will have next speaker meeting with Sue V as guest. Need is felt for a webpage for ACA India with a dropbox helpline and meeting details. Need for workshops (RSG planned for July 2022). We also welcome suggestions on 3-4 hour workshops which can be conducted over a day so that the newcomers benefit.
