We listen, seeking to understand what these groups are looking for, and attempt to meet their expressed need as best as we can from our pool of resources, facilitating universal inclusiveness, accessibility and affordability of literature and ACA recovery resources (Tradition 5, carrying the ACA message). We honor Tradition 4 (autonomy) for all groups.

Partner within WSO ACA and our Fellowships around the world to unify our ACA recovery resources.

- 1. Increased accessibility and affordability processes for literature publishing and distribution for emerging countries.
- 2. Increased accessibility and inclusiveness to ACA recovery resources through meeting support, studies, service committees, workshops etc.
- 3. Supporting translations and equitable access to the WSO ACA Fellowship and organization.
- 4. Partner with Europe and North America in unifying our WSO ACA resources for our world-wide Fellowship.

COUNTRY AND REGIONAL HIGHLIGHTS

Updates:

East Asia [Sean H]

We are establishing roles and responsibilities in our Intergroup structure. We're providing support for the Chinese translation team. We're preparing a proposal for the Publishing Committee to acquire literature regionally. We're continuing to work on establishing our panel for our AWC workshop.

Japan [Eriko I]

Global continues to support the Japanese ACOA Intergroup business meeting. Global is working alongside the Publishing Committee to arrange the printing of translated literature: Japanese BRB and Japanese YWB. Printing commenced in March.

Thailand [Brian Ph]

Officially registered the Young ACA Bangkok meeting. ACA has it posted. Attendance down on both Tuesday, Thursday ACA online meetings. Will take the Songkran holiday a chance to relaunch both meetings with new Zoom meeting rooms April 18. The meetings have been listed under local, so asked to change them to Zoom only. Something is messed up because now I can't see either meeting under local or online. No conversation about opening an in-person meeting in Bangkok right now. COVID cases are still running high. Made contact with the Chiang Mai branch. They said they have one in-person meeting open at night.

South Asia [Shangreila S]

India [Shangreila S]

- 1. ACA India has been invited to participate at equal footing with Al-Anon in an AA convention in North India during 2-4 June, 2022, where we shall have a meeting room for 2 full days for workshops and ACA meetings as well as participation in the main conference room for ESS or other Pi workshop and sharings. This is India's largest aa convention held annually.
- 2. Inter group India is debating procurement of literature prior to the June 2– 4 convention.
- 3. Hindi translations of basic tri-folds such as Essentials, Emotional Sobriety, FAQ and few more are well underway. And under peer review by using in newly started ACA Hindi meeting group.

Central & Southern Africa [KarenT]

We are working on putting a panel together for the AWC to share our ESH on what it means to us to live beyond mere survival.

South Africa [KarenT]

We've received our first print of the Yellow Steps Workbook (YWB) and are expecting our Strengthening My Recovery (SMR) order by the end of April. Being able to answer the ongoing need for literature with both affordability and speed is having a positive impact on our local fellowship.

Regional Development:

Global Members have created Regional Service coordinators and committees serving many countries in a geographic area. We started with the Far East with Taiwan, Vietnam, China, Japan and Singapore and more countries are joining. We have also added Regional Service Coordinators and Committees in Africa, Middle East, South Asia and Oceania. This will increase support and fellowship for countries requesting support in a regional area.
