We outgrew our existing office of 6 years and began looking for a new office about 6 months ago. It needed to be the right mix of office and warehouse space for our staff and book storage. It also needed to be located in a specific geographic area so as not to lose dedicated trained employees by them having to long of a commute.

We searched and searched and after visiting about a dozen potential sites, we finally found the one that fit just right. WSO signed the lease on July 6th and in just about three weeks we had it painted, the carpet and flooring cleaned and are completely moved from the old office into the new office.

The staff did a great job with everyone pitching in and getting move-ready. The contractors we hired to do the prep work came through on time. As of this moment we are operating in the new office at 1901-1903 E 29th Street, Signal Hill, CA 90755.
