To create a WSO Publishing Committee that will centralize and direct all publishing activities, and ensure efficient, affordable delivery of literature to the entire world fellowship, with consistent business practices and oversight.

Activities & Accomplishments:

1. Publications: We are working on A New Hope and the Simplified Chinese Twelve Steps of Adult Children. We have completed 6 new translated ebooks, including Danish, Finnish, Greek, and Swedish languages. In order to keep up the supply for our fellowship, we have reprinted 15,000 more Loving Parent Guidebooks.

The Loving Parent Guidebook is being translated into several languages, including Spanish, Italian, German, and Dutch.

Upcoming publications include Connections, Ready, Set, Go and the Lithuanian YWB.

2. Accessibility with our Publications: We continue to increase accessibility with ebooks by converting past translated books to ebooks as the funds allow. 3 years working on backlog of past translated books into ebooks depending on funds and resources, caught up Dec 31, 2023. We have ebooks in 12 translated languages for a total of 21 ebooks.

3. International Literature Scholarship Fund: We discussed with the Global Members Chair a ballot proposal to expand and clarify the fund to include translation expenses when there is no machine translation capability and using a professional translator is needed. Supported the Board with WSO analysis needed for 2 proposals.

4. Intellectual Property- Copyright: We continue to work on copyright issues and queries.

5. Translations: We are currently supporting over 10 translation teams: Arabic, French, Greek, Hebrew, Hindi, Italian, Japanese, Portuguese, Russian, and Spanish.

There are many translations in various stages of development. We have 35 publication translations in process, which include the Arabic, Hindi, Hebrew, and Spanish translation of all 5 books, the Japanese LPG and Lithuanian YWB being finalized, and the Polish BRB due shortly.

We have created a new tri-fold to increase communication and education about the translation process.

6. Literature: We are working with the literature committee publishing “A New Hope”. We are also working on the final requirements for publishing “Ready, Set, Go”.

7. Audio recordings: We have requested audio books to be developed in the 2024 budget if the funds are available. The 2024 publishing budget was approved. We will start developing a plan to produce 1-2 audio books in 2024, more as funds permit.

8. Website: We have updated the Publishing Committee webpage. Our Publishing Admin volunteer and IT volunteer have been working on this project. We are looking at creating a section on the projects in development in 2024 once we have the resources.

9. Volunteers: We welcome additional volunteers to join the Publishing Committee and Translations Subcommittee. We need support for communication coordinator, audio recordings, writing projects, volunteer coordinator, and other admin duties. Please come in and join as a guest and meet the volunteers and staff behind the scenes in this exciting work.
