In order to translate ACA literature, it is necessary to have a Translation License Agreement with WSO. This protects ACA copyright and also allows ACA WSO to support translators with resources and guidelines to be able to perform this valuable service as effectively, accurately and efficiently as possible. ACA WSO now has a dedicated Special Worker, Marion M, whose role it is to support Translations Teams to do this important Tradition 5 service.
